The Who...

Who needs apologetics?

- unbelievers, skeptics, atheists (and thus, you!)
- you (a personal need, perhaps)
- our own children/families

Why do our children, those raised in the church, need apologetics?

- Some of them have questions and doubts themselves
- And even if they aren't asking questions...

Potential parenting approaches to deal with "bad ideas" in our culture:

- Isolation
- Inoculation

 Group #2 - truth reinforced, but isolated from hearing about any bad ideas

Yale research study in 1960's:

The goal - convince people of a bad idea - Brushing your teeth is bad for them.

 Group #3 - truth reinforced, but also inoculated with bad ideas

Yale research study in 1960's:

When later exposed to the "bad idea" that brushing your teeth is bad for you, which group was most likely to believe it?

Group #2... The group isolated from the "bad ideas"!

Yale research study in 1960's:

And which group was the least likely to believe it?


Group #3... The group inoculated to the "bad ideas"!


Truth claims of Christ:

- John 17:17 Thy word is truth.
- John 14:6 I am the way, the truth, and the life, no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

vs. Our culture's truth claims:

- Truth is relative.
- Live your truth... Be true to yourself.

 Feelings of Inadequacy (you're in good company here!)

Exodus 4:11 - 12 - God's guarantee

"And the Lord said to him, Who has made man's mouth?... Is it not I the Lord? Now go, and I will be with your mouth and teach you what you shall speak."


